The Great Fire of London started in the early hours of the morning on Sunday 2nd September 1666. According to Thomas Farriner, who owned the bakery where the fire started, when he and his family went to bed in their upstairs lodgings just after midnight, everything was fine. However, a mere few hours later, their bakery would be the epicentre of a fire of devastating proportions that would sweep through London and change its landscape.

It is now believed that the fire was caused by an errant ember burning in the oven of the bakery. The fire was discovered by the family's teenage son, and they were able to escape to a neighbour's house from an upstairs window. However, the fire spread quickly amongst the cramped and narrow streets, helped along by a high wind and the cheap wood and thatch which formed the building materials for most of the houses.
